

# Eight Easy Pieces

## 52-1/2" x 67-1/2" Finished

### An SQeasy Pattern

This is a great pattern for beginners. No seams to match!

Please read all instructions before beginning your project.

All seam allowances are 1/4" unless other-

#### Fabric Requirements:

1/2 yd of eight different fabrics  
Select one fabric to be used for binding

#### Step 1 - Cutting Fabrics

**NOTE:** Choose (5) fabrics which will be used for the rectangle ends on the odd numbered rows.

From those fabrics, cut (8) 8" squares and (2) 4-1/4" x 8" rectangles.

From the other (2) fabrics, cut (9) 8" squares.

#### Step 2 - Assembling the Rows

Lay the squares out in a pleasing arrangement.

All odd rows will have one block of each color and one color of the rectangles cut in Step 1.

All even rows will have one block of each color.

#### Step 3 - Sewing together

Begin by sewing all the blocks in Row 1 together. Press all seams in the same direction. Figure 1.

Sew the blocks in Row 2 together. Press all seams in the opposite direction from Row 1. Figure 2.

Repeat Rows 1 and 2 until all 9 rows are sewn. Remember to press each row in the opposite direction from the one before it. Figure 3.

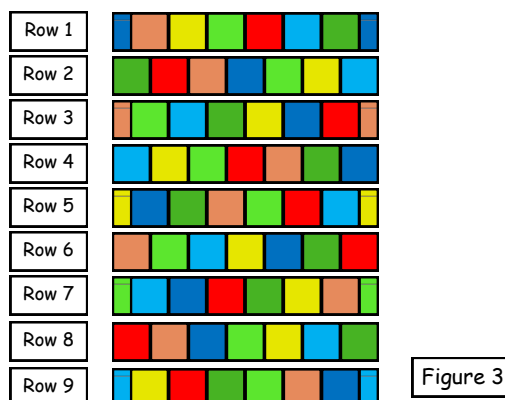

Now stitch all the rows together. Figure 4.

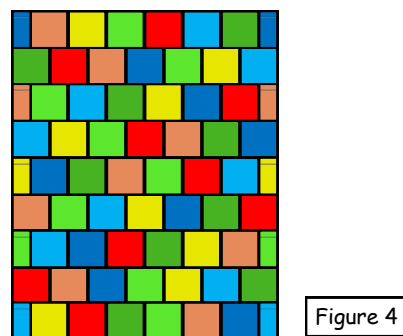

Quilt as desired. Cut binding from reserved fabric.
